Since many outlet stores also carry uniform clothing here is a list of the following essentials that each elementary student at Meadow Montessori School must have. Preschool uniforms are not required but strongly suggested – all preschool items including muddy buddies are available from Cambridge uniforms.

Basic black dress shoes for wearing inside the classroom, these must also be easy for your child to put on and take off, so please do not send shoes with laces if your child is not confident with laces yet. These shoes stay at the school so ensure your child wears outside shoes to school and changes into these once he/she is here. ***Please, black runners are acceptable only if they are all black and non-marking. NO FLAT SHOES – OR SANDALS – ensure the shoes have support.***

Kindergarten to Grade 6 REQUIRED - School cardigan or vest - burgundy, embroidered. (Cambridge) Please ensure your child's name is clearly labelled in the sweater. This is an item we consistently have issues with students losing or mixing up.

Grade 7 students: It is our tradition to supply a **School hoodie, navy, embroidered, with last name on sleeve. (Cambridge)**

- At least 2 school polo shirts, embroidered**, long-sleeve or short sleeve, **navy or white** for outings. **(Cambridge)** Other shirts may be purchased elsewhere without the embroidery for everyday use with the following exceptions: **white embroidered shirts must be worn on field trips and for Formal Dress uniform occasions.** If blue shirts are purchased elsewhere, they must be a very close match to our dark NAVY blue school colours (not royal blue).
- Grade 1 to Grade 6 REQUIRED Gym strip: Navy sport shorts & light grey t-shirt with gold MMS emblem. (Cambridge)** When we speak of sport shorts we are talking about shorts such as soccer shorts, loose fitting and quick-dry fabric. **It is essential for your child to wear the appropriate gym strip during P.E. class.**
- We have added a navy rain shell/ water repellant jacket and rain pant set to our Cambridge lineup. The benefit to this rain suit is that it works well for layering, shorts and a hoodie could be worn underneath for additional warmth if required. Please note due to the pandemic, much of our PE may be outside.**
- NON-MARKING gym shoes**, these should have excellent support and be designed for sports and extended bouts of running; no flat shoes and no shoes that light up please.
- Pants/Skirts: Khaki dress pants or dress shorts. Or a skirt or tunic in khaki or the beautiful school plaid (Cambridge).** The school plaid from Cambridge uniforms is the only plaid permissible**. With skirts or shorts children can wear **navy or white stockings/socks**. We will have crazy sock days! **Our uniform does NOT include leggings (worn alone without a skirt), jeggings, jeans, cargo pants or tank tops.**
- Optional:** School Hoodie, Sweatpants, Yellow muddy Buddies for Pre-k & K students (Cambridge), Navy rain suit
